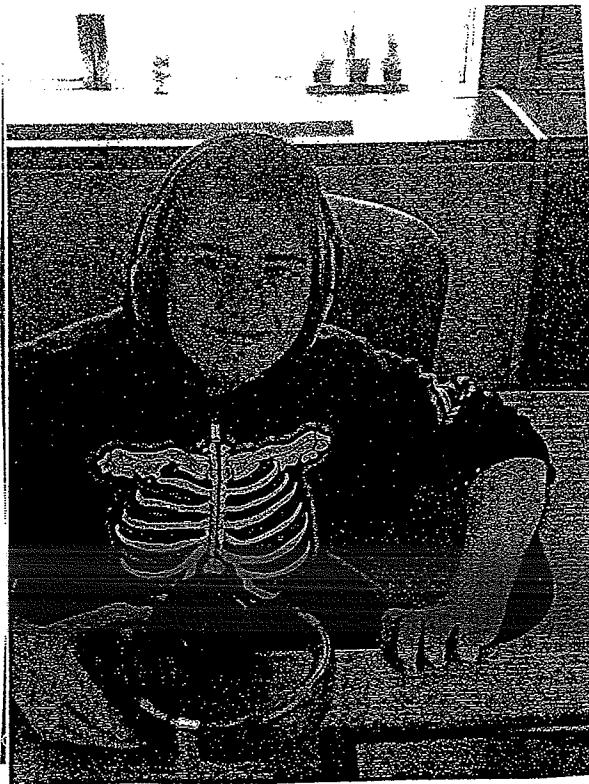
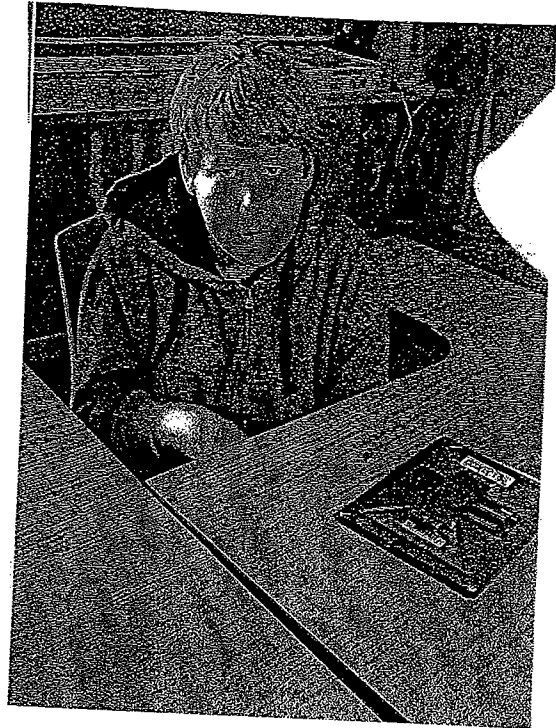
Testing

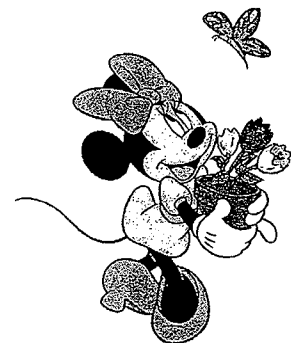

Christian enjoys taking walks, field trips and learning new things. Ms. Palumbo enjoys the guest speakers, being outside and trying new things.

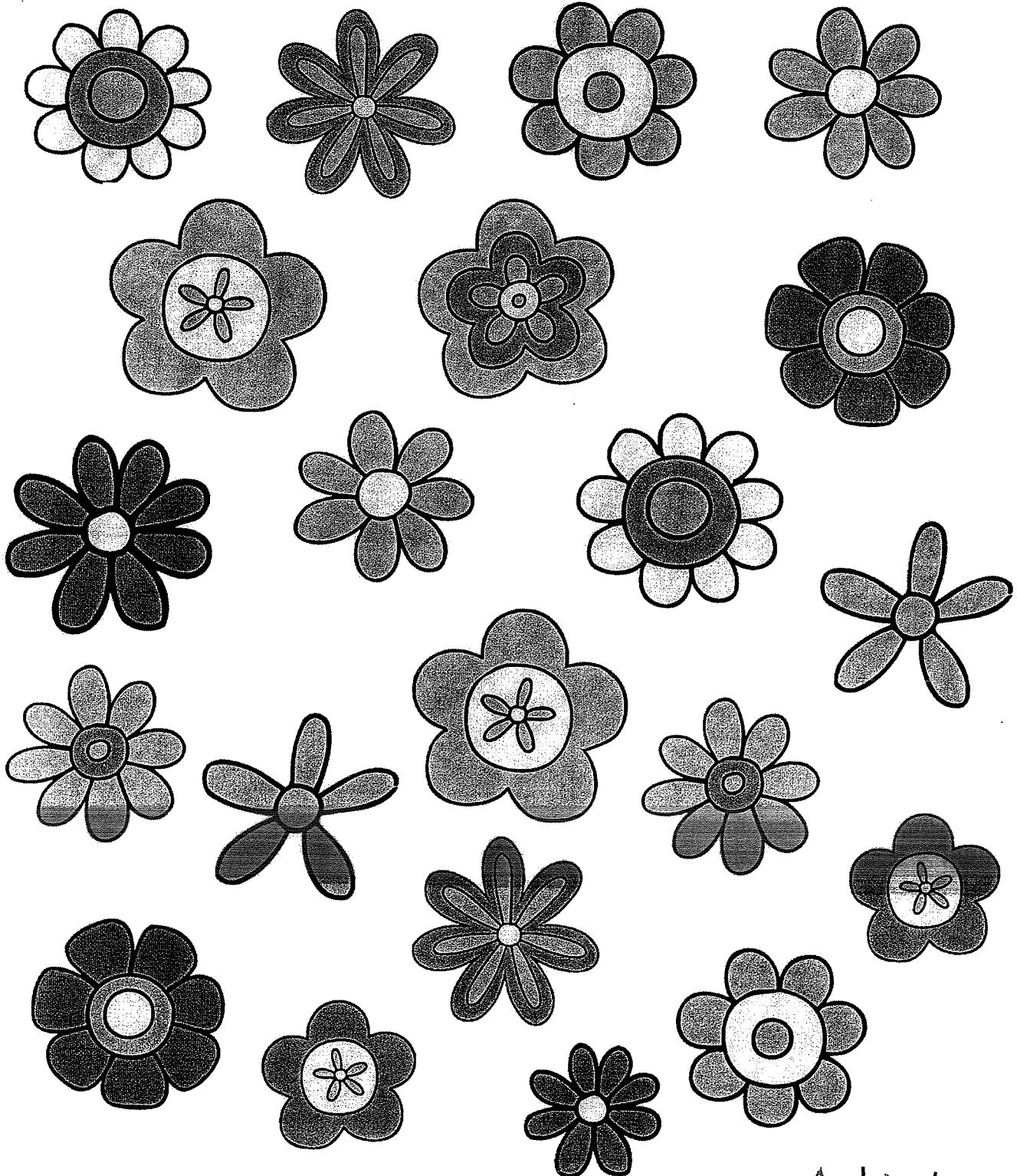
Ms. Palumbo's wish list for the class includes: a school bus, access to more gym equipment, and money to buy healthy snacks.

Match the pairs of spring flowers to find the odd one out.

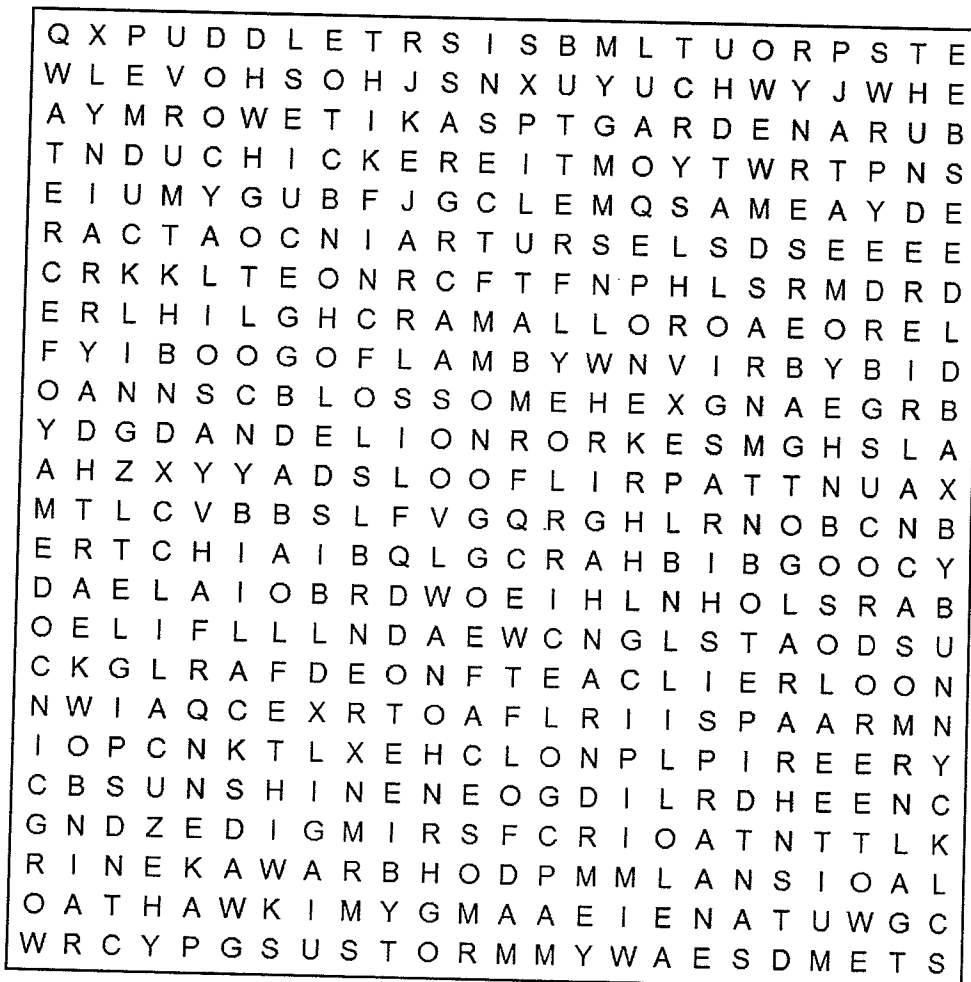
