James Jobb is returning to RCAA for the 2016-2017 school year. Many students contacted him via Facebook and email and told him how much they missed him and how he belonged at this school.

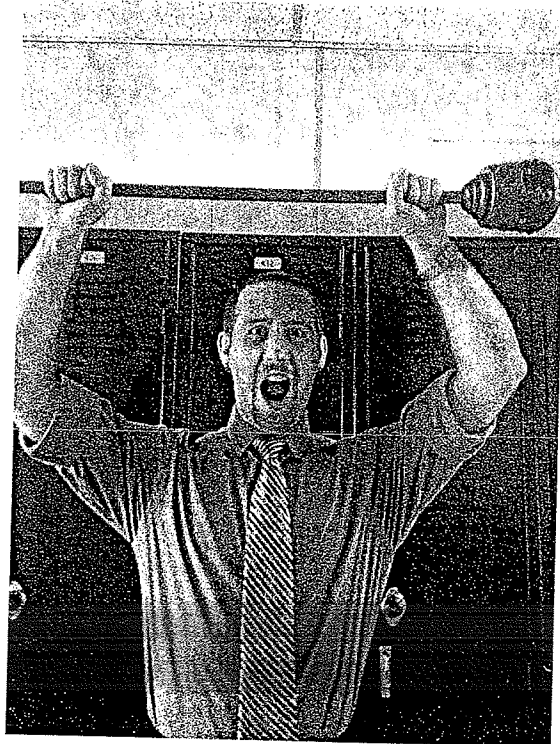
When he left for Waukesha West High School, he said, "When this opportunity came around, it was a very difficult decision for me to make. Ultimately though, it was the right decision for me."

Mr. Jobb winning the spirit stick last year.

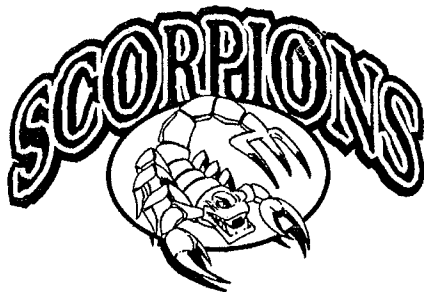
Advisory Update

Mrs. Watson's Advisory recently received \$10,000. They plan on spending the money on the school to make it look better.

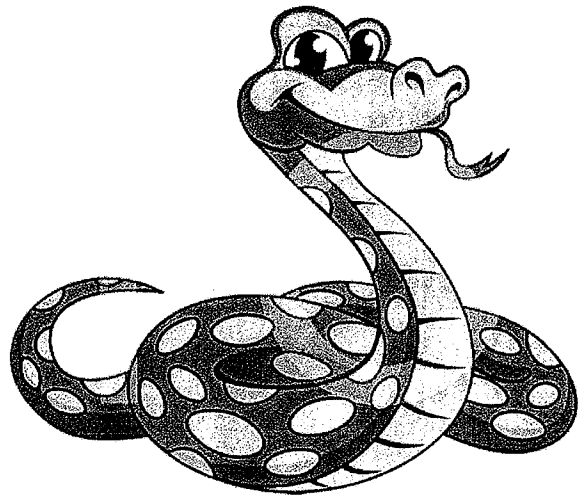
The pets adopted by this advisory are a scorpion and a tarantula. Zane said, "They are cool. You get to hold them."

The pet adopted by this advisor is a snake. Zhoë says, "Snakes are fun to play with."

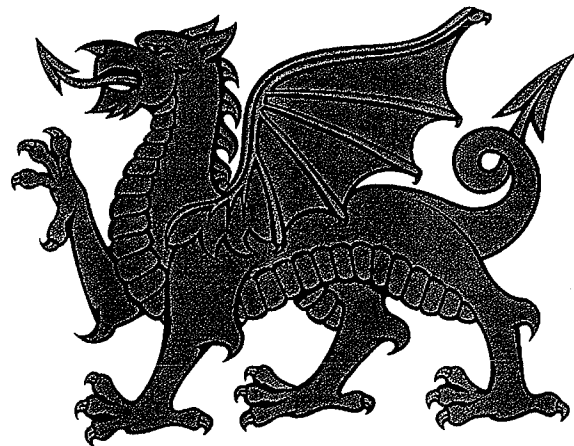


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Mr. LaMasters Advisory is planning on traveling to the Discovery Center. Alexis Faust says, "The Discover Center is hands on and we can learn a lot."

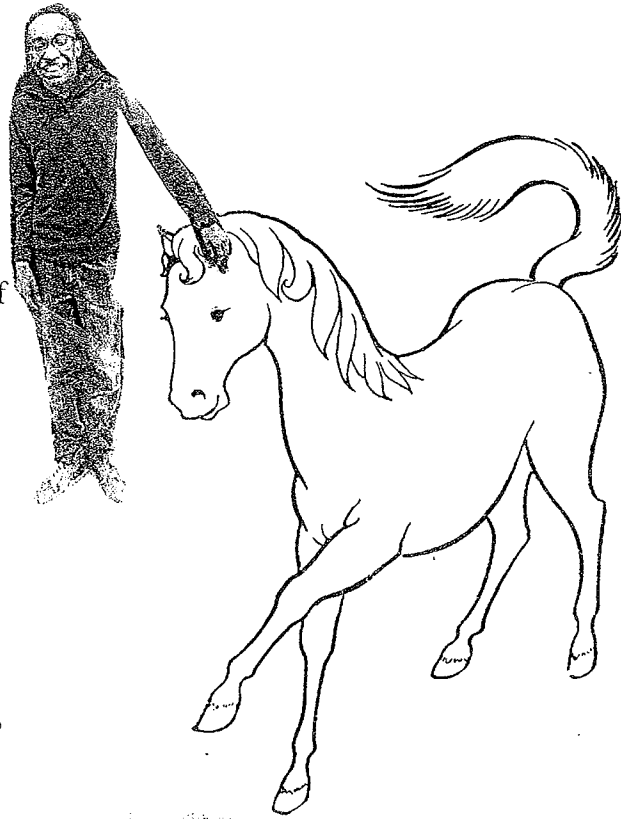

Ms. Larson said that she would purchase her meat elsewhere and that this should never be an issue again.

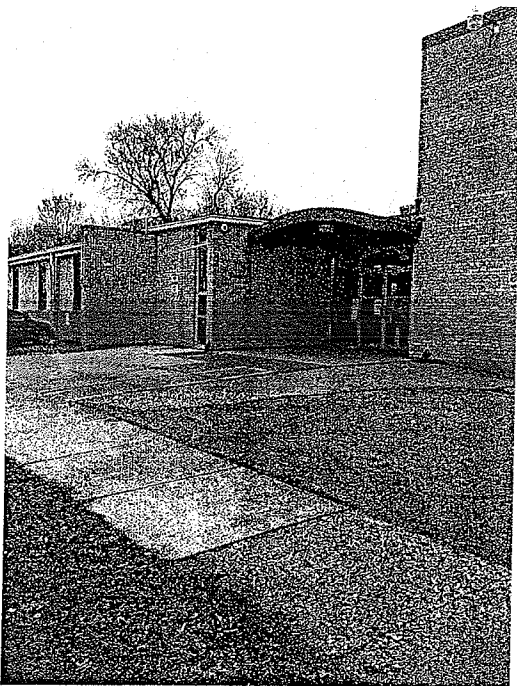


New Building

Deja and Ms. Palumbo left mad at Mrs. Watson but the next day they were fine.



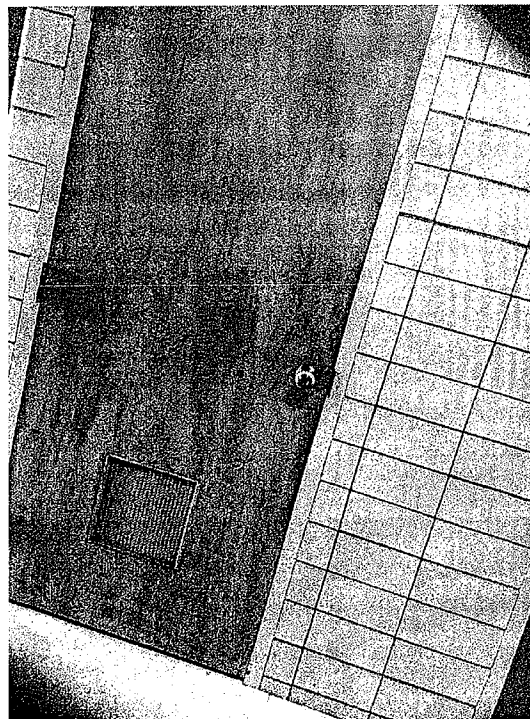
Be Thankful You're in the "Wight" Building!

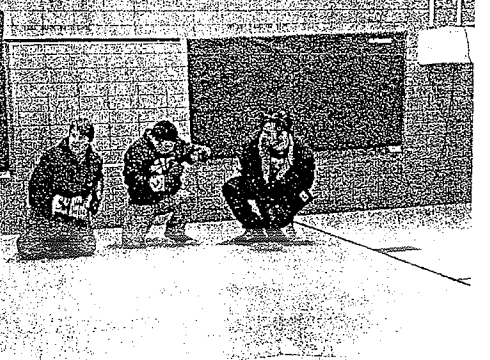
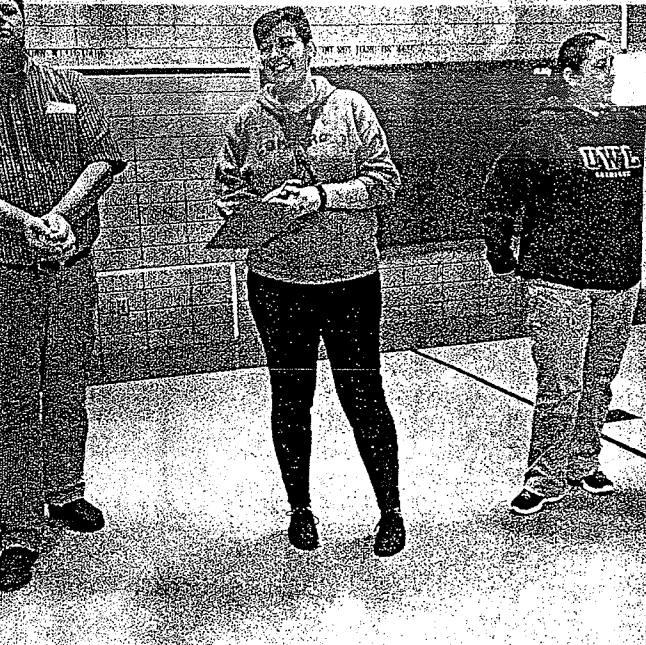
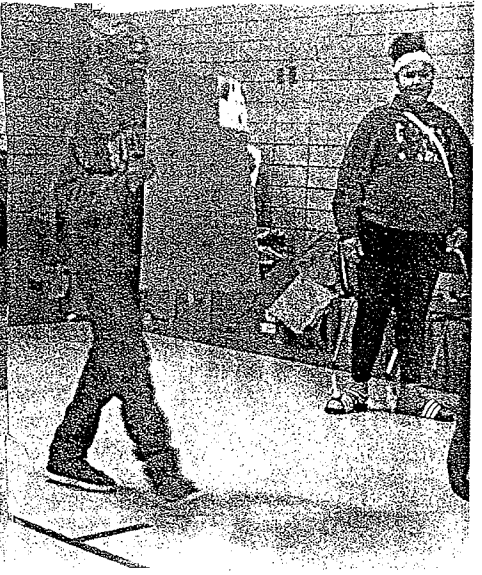
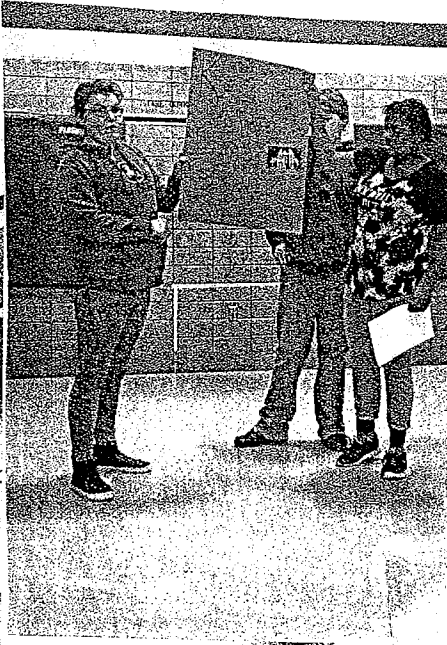
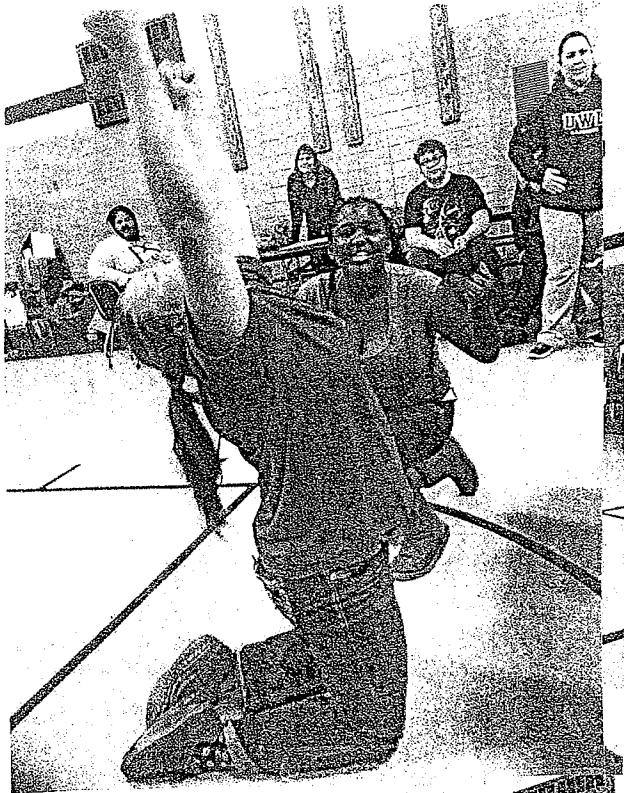
It really is good to be here... in the Right Building!!

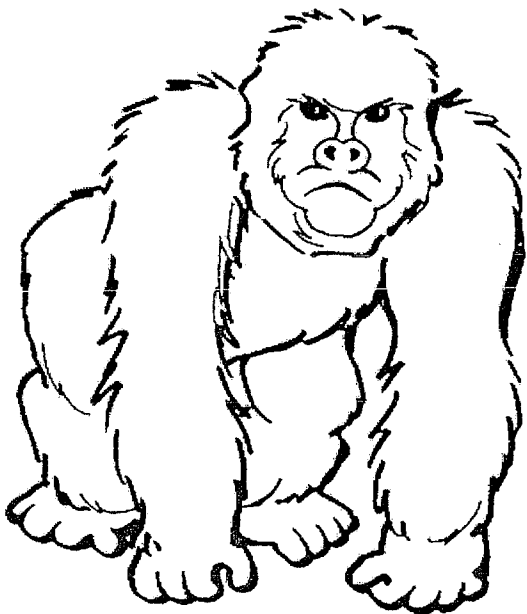

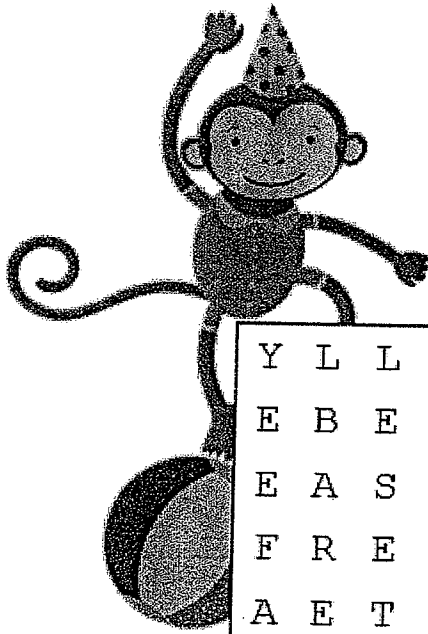

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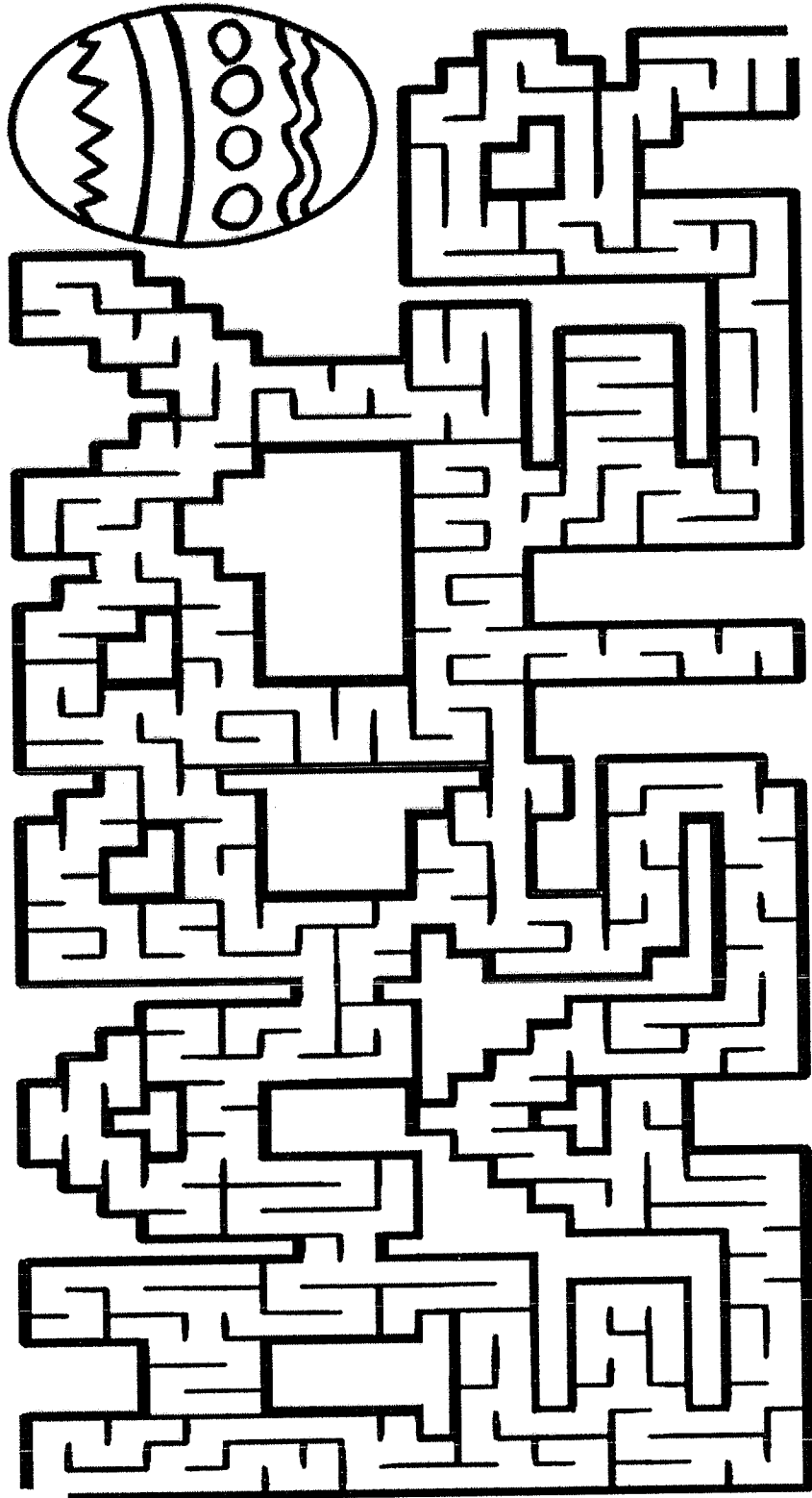
